1.1 Location

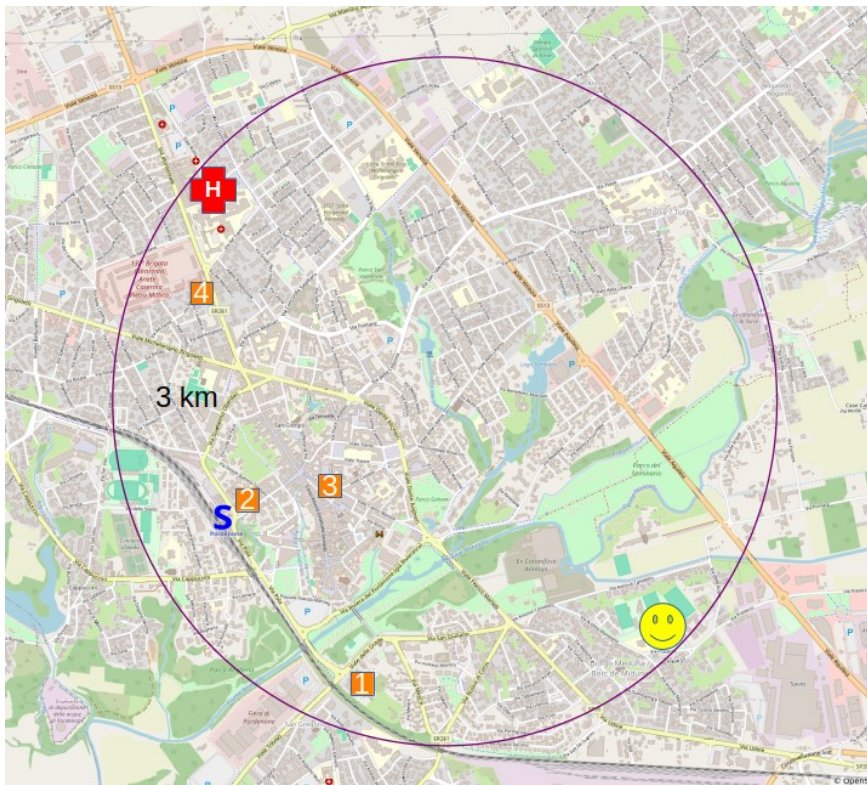

3.1 From the airports

3.1.1 From Venice airport (VCE)

3.1.1.1 Day time table

During the day the best option is to take a shuttle bus towards the train station and then the train.

3.1.1.1.1 Bus from Venice airport to Venezia Mestre train station

The bus stop is located on the lane outside the airport arrivals area.

3.1.1.2 Night time table, direct way

No trains are available during the night time, so the only option is a bus.

3.1.2 From Treviso airport (TSF)

From there it is possible to take the train to Pordenone as seen before, at paragraph Train from Venezia Mestre to Pordenone above.

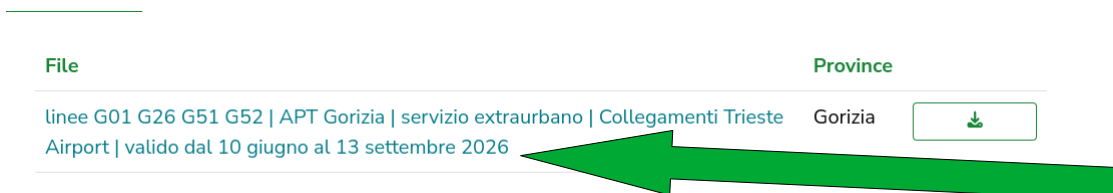
3.1.3 From Trieste airport (TRS)

From this airport the best option is to reach the Udine train station by bus.

3.1.3.1 Bus from Trieste airport to Udine train station

The bus is operated by TPL FVG (info at <https://tplfvg.it/en/>) and takes approx 1 hour or 40 minutes for the direct runs.

Exit at Pordenone Centro.

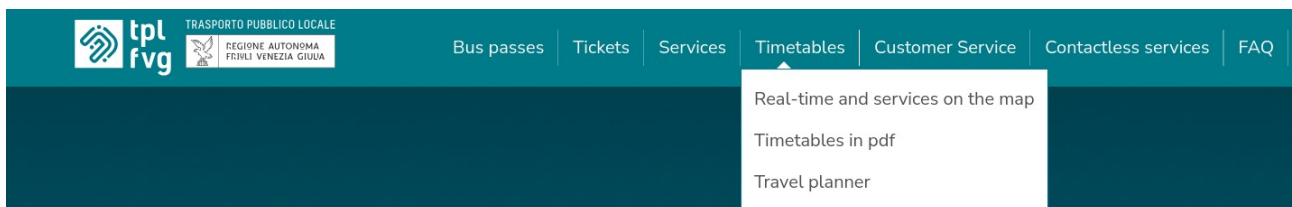
3.2.2 A27 Motorway (Venice – Belluno)

At Conegliano, take the connection to the A28 motorway towards Pordenone. Exit at Pordenone Centro.

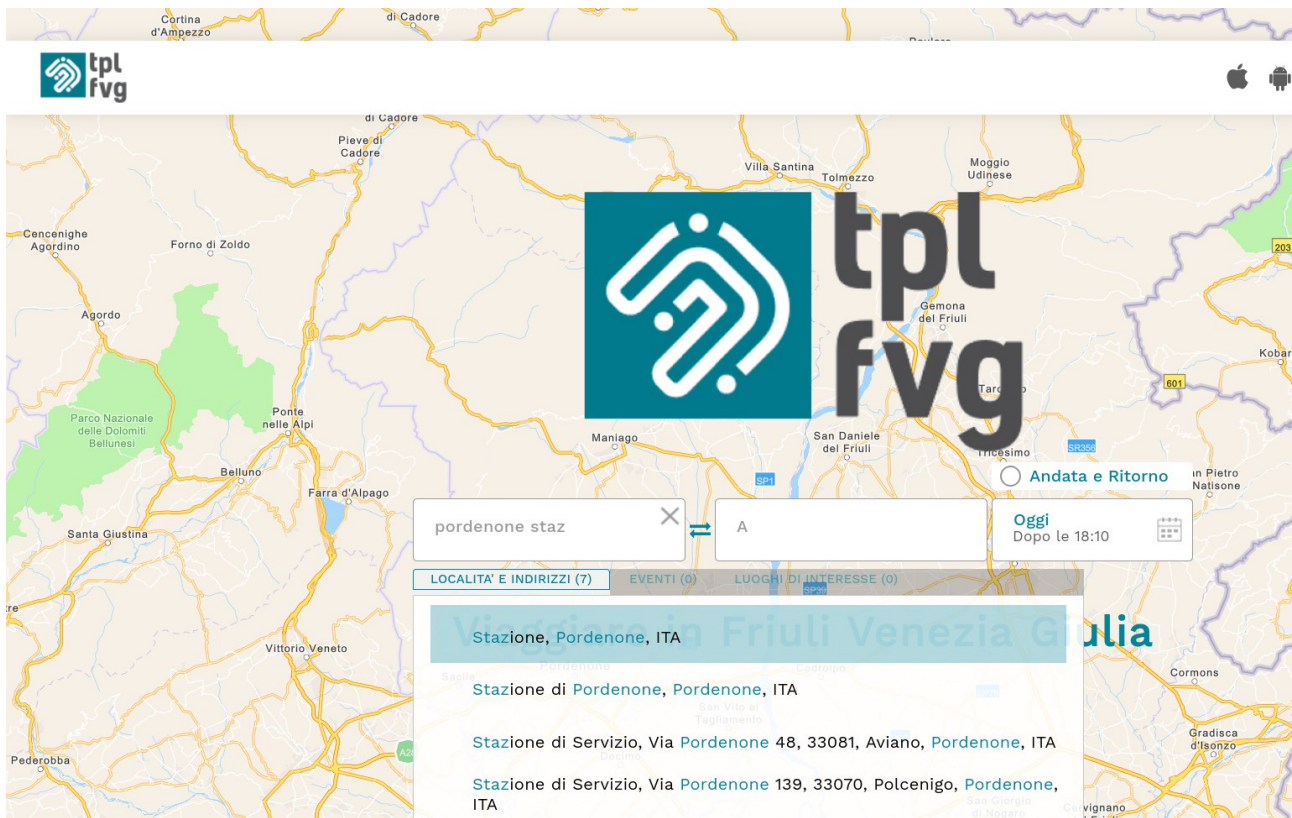

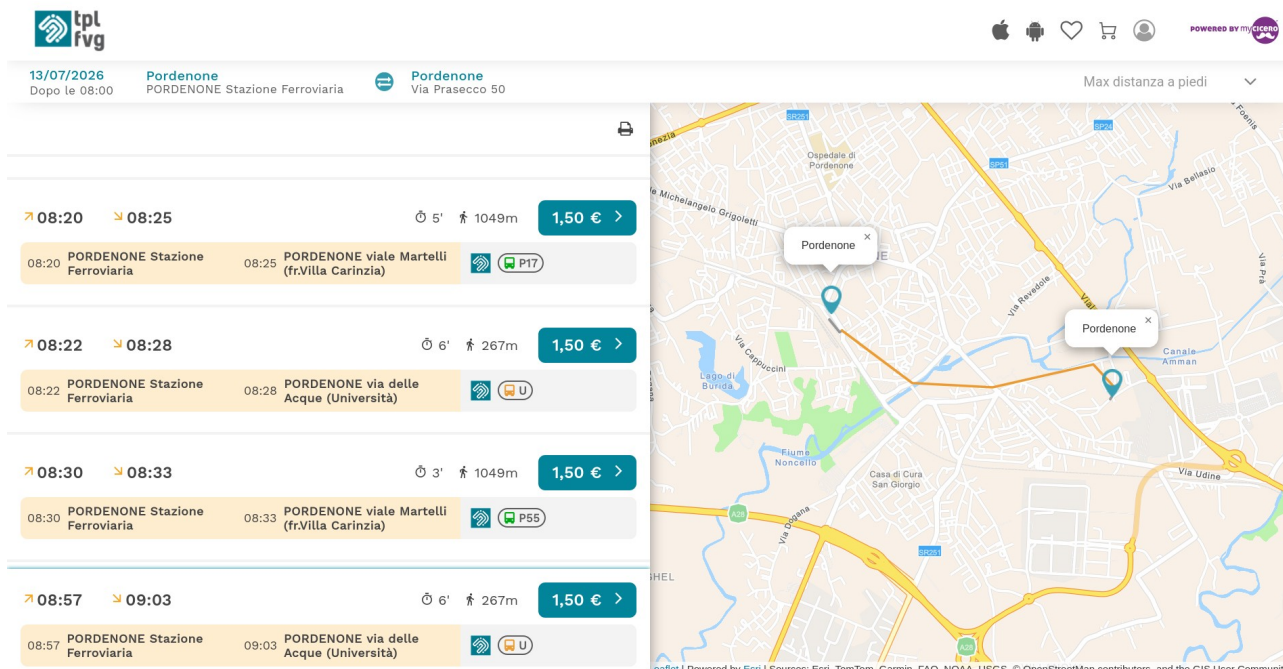
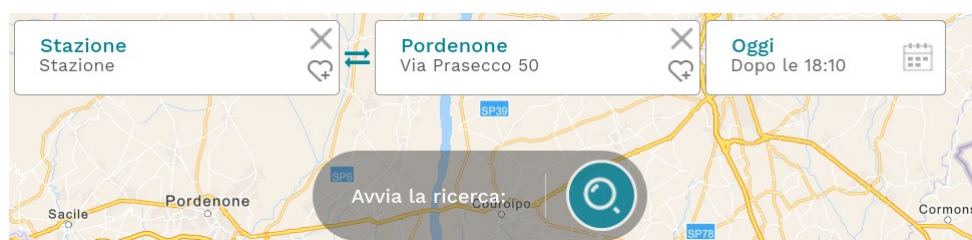
4.1 Buses in Pordenone

7 Essentials

7.1 Required documents for Italy

EU citizens: valid ID card

NON EU citizens: valid Passport with at least 3 months deadline. Depending on nationality, a visa may be required.

7.2 Language

Italian is the official and mostly spoken language. Younger people often speak english.

7.3 Currency

Italy uses the Euro as currency.

It's possible to pay by cash or Credit Cards, accepted almost everywhere (VISA, MasterCard, AMEX, in order of spreading).

Money exchange: it's possible and usually more convenient in banks, during opening hours, and in exchange shops. At ATMs you can withdraw money by card.

7.4 Electricity

In Italy the electrical power is delivered with a 230 V voltage at 50 Hz. The sockets are either:

- Type L: 3 poles Italian with 2 possible paces (https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/CEI_23-50) or dual pace, compatible with EuroPlug (<https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Europlug>);
- Type F: also known as Schuko (<https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Schuko>), in Italy it is adapted to also accept Type L and EuroPlug on the very same socket (almost universal).



7.5 Tap water

It is usually safe to drink tap water, unless differently specified: it is mandatory to place a stamping on taps if the water is not drinkable. The public water supply is regularly inspected by the authorities. Sometimes, however, it is possible to notice a chlorine aftertaste, caused by the sanitisation process.

7.6 Internet and phone services

EU citizens usually have a free roaming service included in their mobile plans.

For NON EU citizens a check with own operator is required.

If a roaming with Italy is not included or not convenient, it is possible to buy a SIM card in Italy in telephony shops or even in Super Markets: some brands have their own mobile service, usually very cheap (it may cost as low as 15€ for the SIM with one month of calls and data included).

8 Food & Drinks

8.1 Local Classics

Pordenone and Friuli Venezia Giulia boast a rich gastronomic identity. You should try regional specialties such as **San Daniele ham**, **Montasio cheese**, and **Frico** (a traditional dish made of cheese and potatoes). And others typical composed plates that restaurants or trattorie can serve to you for dinner or lunch.

8.2 Drinks

The region is world-renowned for its wines (such as those from the **Friuli Grave** or **Collio** areas). Try Merlot, Refosco or Cabernet for the reds or Verduzzo, Friulano (for which has been a long diatribe with Hungary for the name Tocai, and we have lost it), Pinot (in the white or grey fashion) and many, many others.

8.3 Special Needs

Most restaurants in the city center are familiar with vegan and gluten-free requirements. The region promotes "Food and Wine" routes that cater to diverse preferences.

9 Safety & etiquette

9.1 General Safety

- Pordenone is considered a very small and safe city for visitors. As any other city, it is always a good idea to pay attention to crowded areas or isolated zones.

9.2 Tipping & Service

- In Italy, tipping is not considered a common practice, partly because a cover charge called "coperto" is usually added to the bill.
- It is appreciated when the service is considered excellent.

9.3 General Emergency Number **112** (EU wide)

The 112 number is valid EU-wide for any emergency (Police, Ambulance, Fire Brigade) always available (24/7).

9.4 Hospitals & Emergency Room (Pronto Soccorso)

Pordenone is equipped with hospital facilities to ensure safety and security.

9.5 Multilanguages service

For not Italian speaking people, when calling 112 a "conference" system is started between the user, the operator, and the translator (14 languages).

9.6 Non-urgent Access 116117

116117 is the new European non-emergency call number, for accessing **non-urgent medical assistance** and other low-intensity/low-priority local health services.

- It is always available (24/7) in multi language;
- Outpatient clinics open from 8:00 PM to 8:00 AM (7 days a week), also from 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM on Saturdays, Sundays, and bank holidays;
- The Tourist Medical Emergency **service is subject to a fee.**

EU citizens: with the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC), they can access necessary healthcare through the SSN;
