It is possible to migrate to a LibreOffice based product, saving money, future proofing documents, and using cost savings to improve staff training & productivity & business-process



Some advice from TDF

Why not just use LibreOffice for free?

"The Document Foundation encourages large organizations deploying LibreOffice to do so in conjunction with a support partner, who can carefully assess specific requirements, help manage migration and provide bespoke fixes for identified issues. Purchasing LibreOffice support from a TDF partner also provides enterprises with an indirect means to contribute financially to the project, thereby funding its development, improving its stability, and accelerating its growth." cf. release-notes



Recommended – use Certified Professionals

This is an OpenSource code-base: DIY is possible!

- As with Home Electrics, and/or self Gas Boiler maintenance
 - There are some risks... you may even be required to have professional supervision / sign-off ... professionals unlikely to help fix your mess for free.

Technical support levels

- Level 1 support basic support and troubleshooting
- Level 2 support power user level, configuration issues

Outsourced to Partner or handled internally by the Customer

 Level 3 support – resolution of the issue requires fix at the sorce code level, PTF (program temporary fix) build provided

L3 issue life cycle

- Confirmation, first evaluation
 - Depending on SLA, typically within 24h
- Fix in source code, PTF build provided
 - Depending on complexity and urgency, few days or weeks
- Fix in next Collabora Office release for all Collabora customers
 - Up to 1 month
- Fix in upstream LibreOffice release for everyone
 - Up to 6 months!



Preparation & Piloting

Things that don't work:

• "I've installed LibreOffice as well as MS Office please try it and tell me if you have issues, we switch next month"

Instead

- Ask teams for templates & frequent documents
 - → test these for interoperability

Either mend documents yourself; or get interop. Fixes

Pilot inside teams

- The Technical Wizard is prolly not the best pilot target
- Add the least technically savvy person in each group too.



Cost / Benefit - Improving your documents

Templates with issues

 Large extant document set with potential problems.

 Legacy documents used regularly

 Significant win from interop. Fix

→ File ticket

→ Deploy fix

Individual, not widely used documents

Fix the templates going forward?

Fix the existing used documents in-house.

Project goals and expectations

Project background



- In 2014/15 the HSC agreed a new Enterprise Agreement with Microsoft for all Trusts which covered a range of software but largely excluded Microsoft Office
- Due for renewal in 2018 and spend estimated up to £60m for HSC
- Microsoft license per user is £145 per year

Cost saving

- In June 2015 Crown Commercial Services agreed an MOU with Collabora Productivity Ltd. permitting all UK public sector organisations to install Collabora GovOffice
- Annual subscription for Collabora GovOffice: £39,000 for 6,500 users
- Annual Level 3 Code Support Contract: £20,000
- Total cost: £59,000

Compare to:

- MS licence per year: £145 × 6,500 users = £942,500
 - Without Level 3 Code Support Contract




Collabora GovOffice - reducing risk

- Backed by a reputable UK company Collabora
- Largest Group of Certified LibreOffice Developers anywhere
- Long term support
- Helpdesk / OTRS issue tracker / SLA
 - Issues are acknowledged and fixed in a timely manner
- Product management interaction
 - Bi-weekly calls to co-ordinate
 - New features:

SharePoint lists, Watermarks, Writer as Mail Merge Data Source, COLEAT, Pivot table interop, Redaction, Interoperable text based form fields, etc.




Our migration advice: If you only remember one thing ...



This can cause a disconnection between areas within an organization.

<u>Everyone</u> installs Collabora Office / GovOffice, to build in compatibility and interoperability.





Step down the use of proprietary licenses as any enterprise agreement allows.

Crucially, from day 1, all proprietary users set **ODF** as their default save setting and any proprietary format anomalies are handled as part of the migration plan.

Unfortunately – stuck with MS formats ...

List is too long to show them all...

Product Management interaction: some fruit ...

"where is the roadmap" ...

"Unfloat table" button

Tables in a Word document that can "float" (text can wrap around them) and at the same time can span across multiple pages if they have enough content. LibreOffice can have TextFrames (containing tables) where content can wrap around them; it can also have tables that span across multiple pages - but not both at the same time.






Date field (with date picker)


New, MS Office compatible Form menu













Text form field: some content




Redaction

"Redaction/Sanitization is the process of removing sensitive information from a document or other message, so that the document may be distributed to a broader audience."




Manual Redaction
