Collabora Online in Nextcloud

- Collabora Online is a full-fledged, web-accessible office suite based on LibreOffice.
- Collabora Online is Open Source, self-hosted and secure!
- View, create and edit documents directly in your Nextcloud
- Under your control

Other features

- Collabora Online provides Nextcloud users with a full cloud document suite handling all major documents, presentations and spreadsheet formats while retaining privacy and security.
- The 'shared editing' capability enables teams to see changes of one editor in real time, avoiding editing and versioning conflicts and complementing the built in secure chat and WebRTC video conferencing in Nextcloud.

Conclusions

- Always go for open source solutions when saving your data in the cloud
- If you are a privacy concerned person or need a secure collaborative solution for yourself, community or business, this integration is a good solution for that.
