 - The bug is bisected
- Otherwise, they go unnoticed

 - \rightarrow Cherry-picked in gerrit

- → Triage it!
 - \rightarrow Prevent bugs from getting lost in the unconfirmed list
 - \rightarrow Reduce responsive time
