- **LibreUmbria** is a success story of a migration to LibreOffice. Our experience proves that the migration to LibreOffice is **feasible**, if some **keywords** are taken into account since the beginning.
- **LibreUmbria** has been designed in collaboration with **The Document** Foundation. The collaboration with such an independent entity has been crucial, and allowed us to adopt a proven and precise **roadmap**.
- **LibreUmbria** played an active role to help The Document Foundation starting the **LibreItalia** initiative, which hopefully will play a strategic role driving migration processes in Italy.

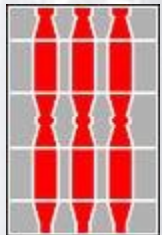

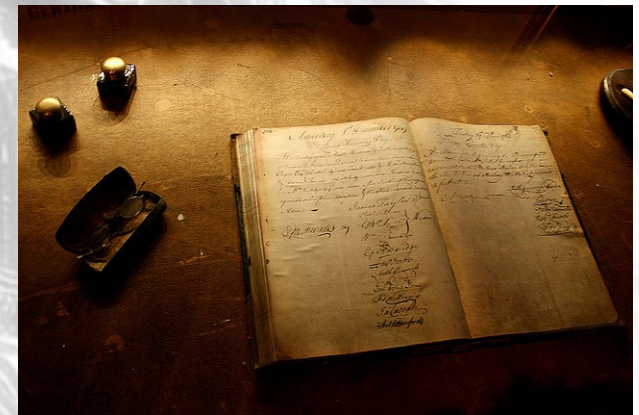
# Awareness

The migration requires to be aware of the internal organization scenario.

This facilitates the identification of the proper **methodology** to adopt, the necessary migration project **activities**, and to identify the critical **steps**.

The **analysis** should identify:

- Which **function** the users are using in their routinary activity
- if they are using **templates**.



# Saving

- LibreOffice allows to save on **licence** costs.
- Furthermore the **reorganization** of the document and spreadsheet production induces an optimization of costs, increasing the global **performance** of the PA.



# Communication

- It is the main keyword of Libre-Umbria success
- The first campaign has been addressed to the top and intermediate management
- After their approval and their involvement in the project the campaign has been addressed to final user and to the news channels



# Communication (i)

- The Blog, always updated
- The activity on the most popular social networks
- The campaign addressed to the specialized and general newspapers and web sites

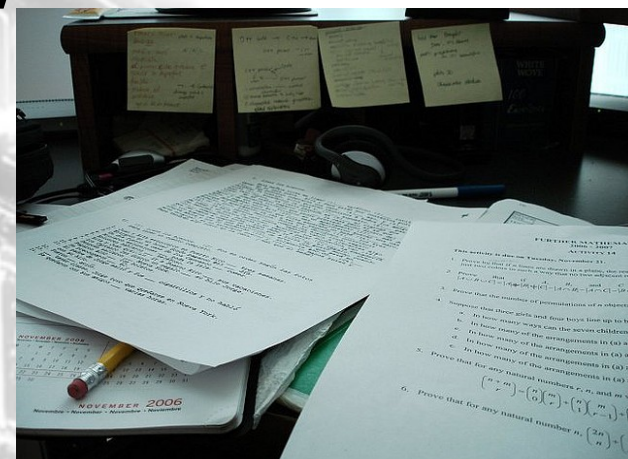
... made **LibreUmbria** very popular on FLOSS Community and on thematic groups (lobby action).





# Moving to the Digital world - dematerialization

- Migrating to LibreOffice an organization will re-engineer the document workflow and facilitates the dematerialization
- The adoption of standard templates is promoted and structured
- We implemented an official extension to simplify the digital signature of a document with a single click
- we are working to integrate LibreOffice with other packages.



# Involvement

- The involvement of the top and intermediate management first, then of the end users, before starting the operations, was crucial
- Strong motivation against the open source
- TDF facilitated tremendously since no specific interests have been felt (antitrust)



# Collaboration

- The collaboration among organizations enriched the project: different experiences and point of view merged together
- People was enthusiast to be part of the process: in this sense the migration was even **easy!**



# Transparency

- The methodology has been generalized in order to facilitate the migration process to others
- In the blog are available all documents (CC licence): project charter and plan, questionnaires, vademecum for teachers, slides, etc



# Education

- The first education process has been addressed to the **teachers**, selected among the employees on a voluntary basis, and to the **technical staff**
- They will be entitled to participate to the LibreOffice **certification**, when available.



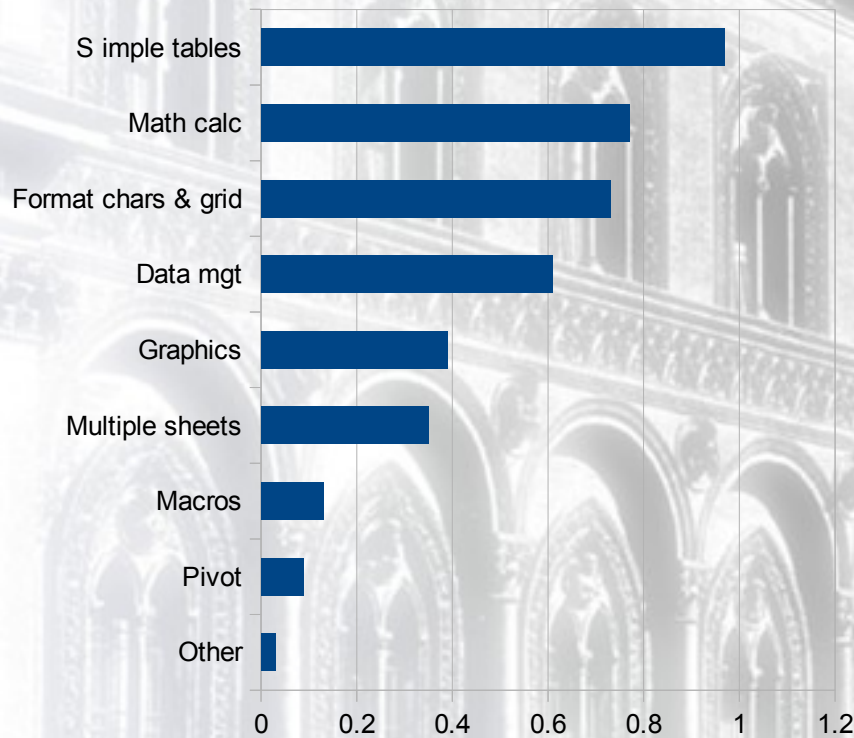
# Education (i)

- We started a massive education campaign to final users (**9** hours, Writer and Calc base);
- Participants have been really satisfied (**90%** very satisfied, **5%** satisfied);
- Teachers have been rated (mean) 4 over 5;
- Advanced courses are planned starting on Nov.

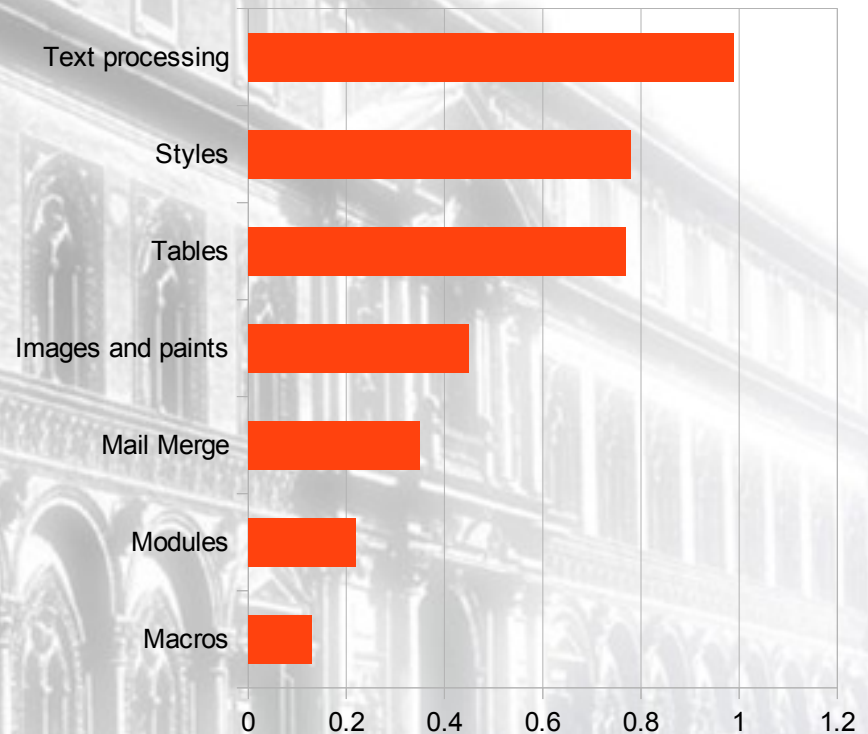


# Education: previous usage of Word and Excel functions

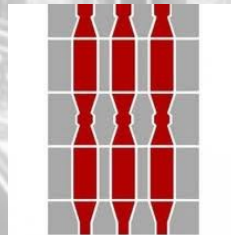

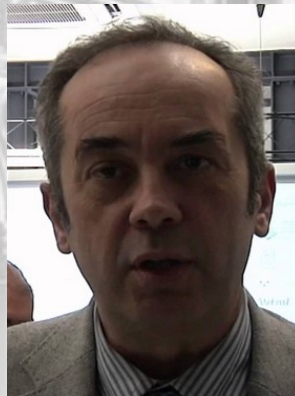
