Always check a module in cleaner than when you checked it out.

- No matter who the original author was,
- no matter how small the change,
- improve the module/file/class/method/variable!

coding style



- (1) sometimes weird style due to 80 character line limit
 - (2) sometimes opposit (but this is kind of OK)
 - (3) weird policy that no braces if only one line after condition
 - (4) inconsistent brace style in one file not uncommon

comments



- (1) comments can be misleading → fix or delete it
 - (2) separator style was common when screens were green on black → nowadays we have syntax coloring → delete these
 - (3) method names duplicated in comments only to avoid warnings from „uncommented method“ script (bin/find-undocumented-classes)
